(**pepito, juanito y fulanito**)

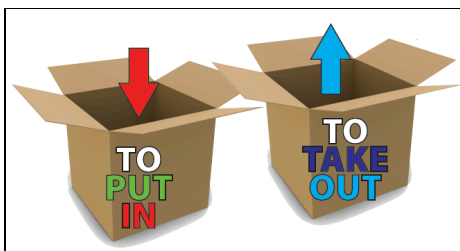
