The watergate scandal

The **Watergate scandal** was a major political scandal that occurred in the United States in the 1970s as a result of the June 17, 1972 break-in at the Democratic National Committee (DNC) headquarters at the Watergate office complex in Washington, D.C., and President Richard Nixon's administration's attempted cover-up of its involvement. When the conspiracy was discovered and investigated by the U.S. Congress, the Nixon administration's resistance to its probes led to a constitutional crisis.^[1] The term *Watergate* has come to encompass an array of clandestine and often illegal activities undertaken by members of the Nixon administration.
