GEEKS

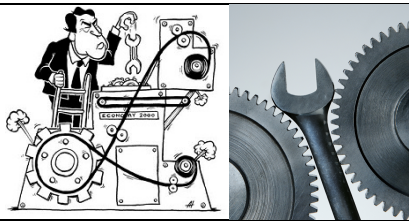
- Early adopters

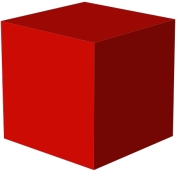
