Tell me if you have **any** problems. (they may not exist)

I want to give you **something** to read. (positive) (a thing)

I don't want to give you **anything**. (negative) (a thing)

Have you got **anything** for me? (I don't know if you have.)

Have you got **something** for me? (I hope/think you have.)

There's **hardly anything** left to eat. (= almost nothing)

Have you seen **anything** interesting lately?

(something/anything + adjective)
