Burst means that there's a skin, cloth or membrane holding everything in, which has ruptured. Balloons, bubbles, cushions, blisters and tummies can burst.

Explode means there's an internal force or reaction (chemical, pressure, nuclear) which destroys its container, and perhaps damages the surrounding area. A bomb can explode, but not burst.

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INTRANSITIVE VERBS

- An action verb that cannot have a direct object to receive the action.
- Many verbs normally do not have an object, they are the intransitive verbs.
- They are often refer to:

Existence	Appear, die, disappear, live, happen, remain.
The human body	Ache, bleed, blush, faint, shiver, smile.
Human noises	Cough, cry, laugh, speak, snore, scream, yawn.
Light, smell, vibration	Glow, shine, sparkle, stink, throb, vibrate.
Position, movement	Arrive, come, depart, fall, flow, go, kneel, run, sit, sleep, stand, swim, wait, walk, work.
