### What is the difference?

**Motorized Pedal-Cycle**



Many motorcycles in history began as an engine in a strengthened bicycle frame, often retaining its sprocket and pedals. Different states determined their own moped defining features since instating their own motor vehicle regulations.

50cc or less engine displacement • under 2 horsepower  
Automatic transmission • Operable pedals (n/a in some states)  
Typically no motorcycle license endorsement is required to ride






**Scooters...**

are recognizable by their legshields and typically smaller wheels. By design, a scooter will have the engine and transmission connected. The 'lean-straddled' style of which the rider sits on a scooter is due to body incorporated running boards and eliminated footpegs. Motor vehicle regulations typically align with that of a motorcycle.

Typically over 50cc engine displacement • Automatic or manual transmission  
A motorcycle license is required **HOWEVER**  
under 50cc displacement machines may be an exception
