To go away for the weekend / holidays.

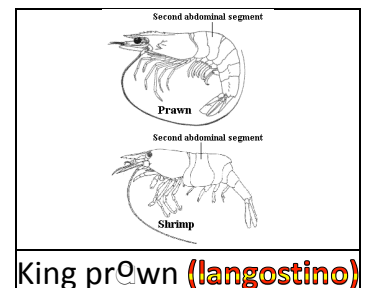
Show (≈caldo/≈cocido)
