Airy-fairy (^{hada})



Impractical and foolishly idealistic.

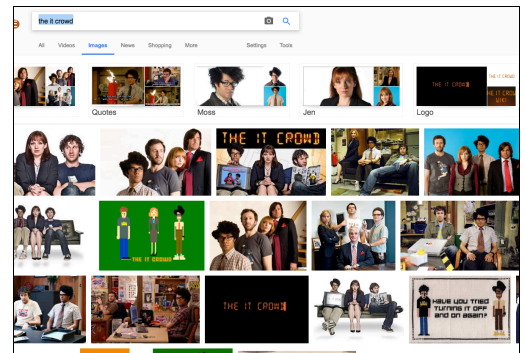
