<p>We use <i>not only</i> "eks" <i>but also</i> "uai" in formal contexts:</p> <p>"The war caused not only destruction and death but also generations of hatred between the two communities."</p> <p>"The car (is) not only is economical but also feels good to drive."</p> <p>We can sometimes leave out <i>also</i>:</p> <p>"I identified with Denzel Washington not only as an actor but as a person."</p> <p>To add emphasis, we can use <i>not only</i> at the beginning of a clause. When we do this, we invert the subject and the verb:</p> <p>"Not only was it raining all day at the wedding but also the band was late."</p> <p>"Not only will they paint the outside of the house but also the inside."</p> <p>When there is no auxiliary verb or main verb <i>be</i>, we use <i>do</i>, <i>does</i>, <i>did</i>:</p> <p>"Not only did she forget my birthday, but she also didn't even apologise for forgetting it."</p>
