Many motorcycles in history began as an engine in a strengthened bicycle frame, often retaining its sprocket and pedals. Different states determined their own isoped defining features since instituting their own motor vehicle regulations.

50cc or less engine displacement • under 2 horsepower
Automatic transmission • Operable pedals (y/n in some states)
Typically no motorcycle license endorsement is required to ride

Typically over 50cc engine displacement • Automatic or manual transmission
A motorcycle license is required **HOWEVER**
under 50cc displacement machines may be an exception
