(Don't let it) Go to your head: when some praise or flattery makes a person feel better or more superior than he/she really is.

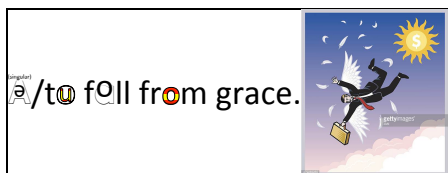
