




For example:	
1. David's cuts always heal quickly. /not/ David's cuts always cure quickly.	
2. David is cured of cancer. /not/ David is healed of cancer.	
(although #2 is not altogether unheard of in some forms of spoken English)	
To cure someone of something also implies that they have been healed of the particular affliction.	
1. Jesus healed/cured the sick.	
2. Scientist find a cure for cancer.
