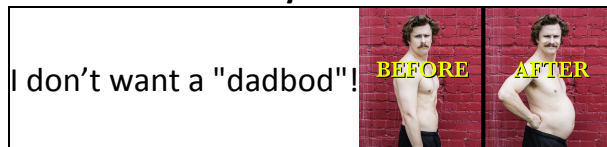

(of an outcome, especially one that is desired) possible but very uncertain.

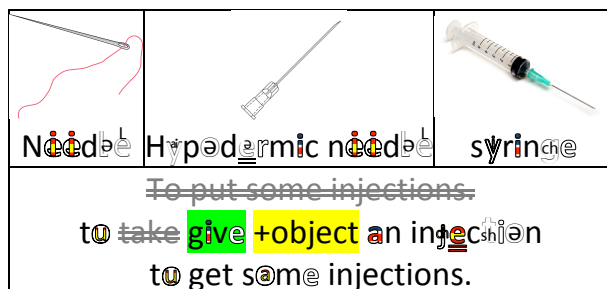
