<p>INTRANSITIVE VERBS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An action verb that cannot have a direct object to receive the action. Many verbs normally do not have an object, they are the intransitive verbs. ****The Phrasal Verb GOLDEN rule:** If you use an **DIRECT OBJECT PRONOUN** (me, you, him/her/it, us, them), the phrasal verb **MUST** be separated, going between the verb and the particle.

Correct: Tom handed **it** in. I took **them** off.
 Incorrect: Tom handed-in-~~it~~. I took-off-~~them~~.



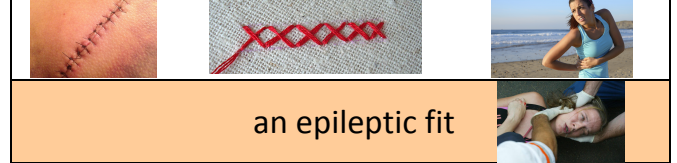

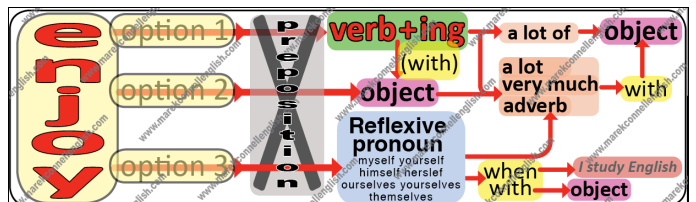
