I took <b>them</b> off.              Incorrect: Tom handed-in <b>it</b>. I took-off <b>them</b>.</p>

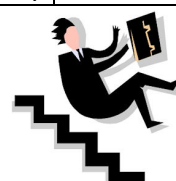
