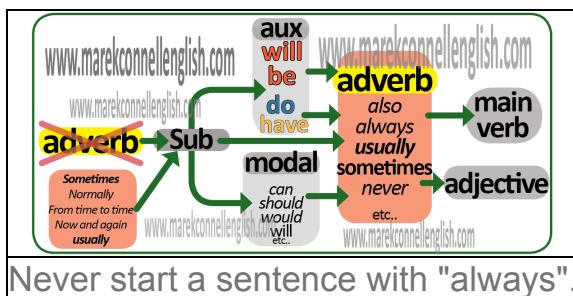

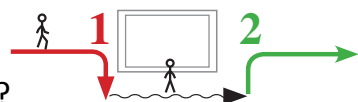

Defining relative clause (Gives us <b>essential</b> information about the subject.)	
Use: <b>that</b> / <b>which</b> / <b>who</b> / <b>where</b> / <b>when</b> <small>(por qué) (quién) (dónde) (cuándo)</small> <b>Why</b> / <b>Who</b> / <b>Whom</b> / <b>Which</b> / <b>whose</b> . <small>(cuando) (por qué) (quién) (dónde) (cuándo) (relativo adjetivo) (relativo adjetivo) (relativo adjetivo) (relativo adjetivo) (relativo adjetivo)</small>	<b>0 commas(,)</b>
You can omit the <b>pronoun</b> if there is a <b>subject</b> before the <b>main verb</b> : He was the man <b>that</b> spoke really quickly. The film <b>(which/ that)</b> <b>we</b> saw was three hours long. The person <b>(that)</b> <b>I</b> know is from Croatia. He is the person <b>that</b> does the work.
