Mind boggling

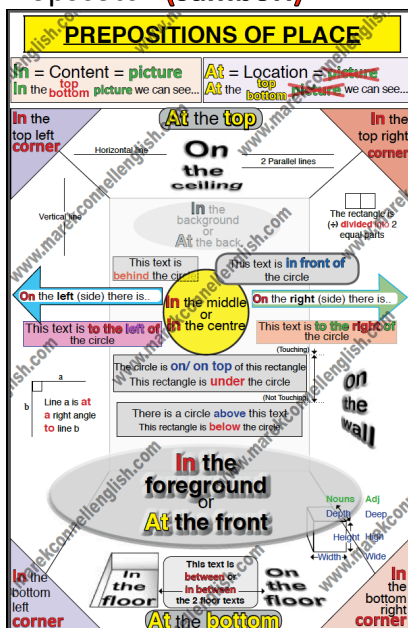
he boggled at the thought of her reaction ->
