*He's been to Paris.* = He went to Paris and came back.

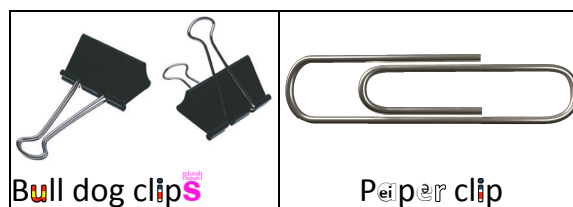
