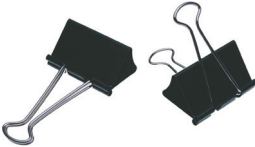

Correct: Tom handed **it** in. I took **them** off.
 Incorrect: Tom handed-in it. I took-off them.

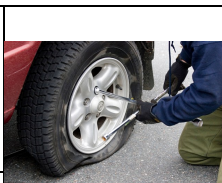
