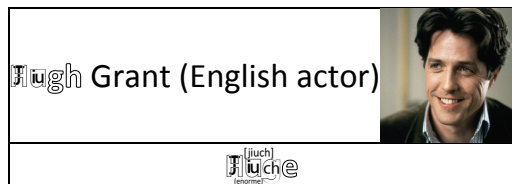

(it doesn't matter which ones)</p> <p>Tell me if you have any problems. (they may not exist)</p> <p>B something/anything</p> <p>I want to give you something to read. (positive) (a thing)</p> <p>I don't want to give you anything. (negative) (a thing)</p> <p>Have you got anything for me? (I don't know if you have.)</p> <p>Have you got something for me? (I hope/think you have.)</p> <p>There's hardly anything left to eat. (= almost nothing)</p> <p>Have you seen anything interesting lately?</p> <p>(something/anything + adjective)</p>
