IF	WHETHER
one use of if: conditional sentences	one use of whether: to show choices or possibilities
EXAMPLES If it rains, we will cancel the picnic. If it rained, you'd get wet. If it had rained, we would have stayed inside.	EXAMPLES We'll have the picnic whether it rains or not. I'll be happy whether it's rainy or sunny! Whether it rains or shines, I prefer to be outside.
Sometimes, if and whether can be used interchangeably.	
I don't know if it rained here on Sunday. I was out of town all weekend.	I don't know whether or not it rained here on Sunday. I was out of town all weekend.

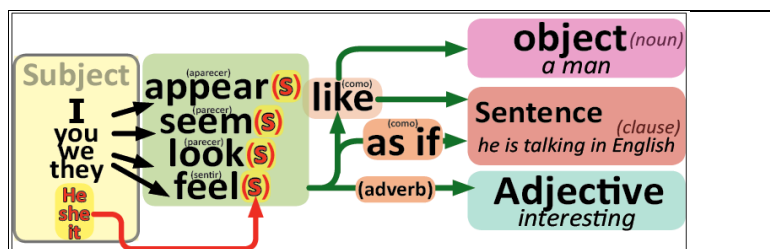

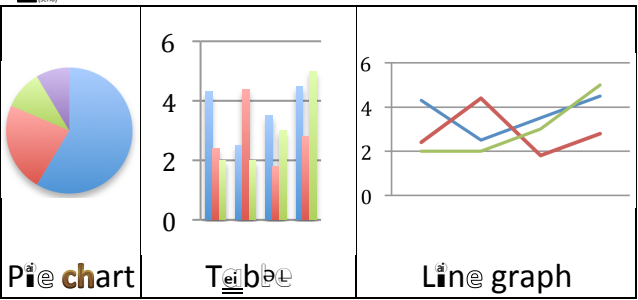
