<p>^{(indefinite) (unspecific)} the next/ last (Unspecific point in time or not the whole period)</p>

- I shall be working for **the next week** and then I shall be on holiday. (= starting now for the next five or seven days)
 - I shall do some work **next week** before I go on holiday.
(= some work, but not every day)
 - I'm going to have driving lessons **next year**.
(= at some point during the year)
- For **the next twelve months** I shall be in Birmingham on a post-graduate course. (= all 12 months, starting now)
- **The last year** has been hell! First the divorce, then I lost my job! (= all 12 months up till now)
 - I got divorced **last year** and I plan to remarry this year.
(= at some point during the year)
 - I've had diarrhea for **the last week**, doctor. (7 days)
 - I had diarrhea **last week**. Couldn't eat anything for three days. (3 days)
