Wake

In someone's wake

Definition of in someone's or something's wake. —used to say what is left behind by **someone** or something. He went from job to job, leaving a trail of broken promises **in his wake**.

Advent (the arrival of a notable person or thing.)

To cut down / back on + object (to reduce)

"I'm trying to cut down on coffee at the moment."
"I'm trying to cut down on bread at the moment."

to calmly deal with something that is unpleasant and not let it affect what you are doing:
There are often problems at work but she seems to take it all in her stride.

to stride (andar a zancadas)

walk with long, decisive steps in a specified direction.

"he strode across the road"

(Sometimes) You have to take it on the chin (el mentón)

You have to sack (chupar) it up

(to accept unpleasant events bravely and without complaining)



To tramp (≈to march)

If you tramp somewhere, you walk there slowly and with regular, heavy steps, for a long time.

To trudge (walk lazily) walk slowly and with heavy steps, typically because of exhaustion or harsh conditions.

"I trudged up the stairs"
