"one of those thingamajigs for keeping all the tools together"

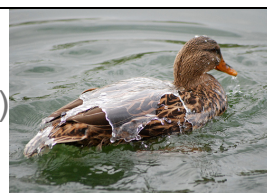
have kitten <sup>(sencillo)</sup> s ("baby cats")
